Funding Programme	The framework for this funding action is the <i>Plan Estatal de Investigación Científica</i> , <i>Técnica e Innovación</i> 2024-2027. On a national level, the Call will be managed by the <i>Subdivisión de Programas Científico-Técnicos Transversales</i> , <i>Fortalecimiento y Excelencia</i> (STRAN) of the AEI. The instrument for funding the Spanish groups requesting funding to the AEI is the corresponding Spanish call "Proyectos de Colaboración Internacional" (PCI) (to be published in due time).			
	As a reference, the applicants are strongly advised to read the call text of the PCI 2025-2 ("BOE Núm. 231 de 25/09/2025") and especially PCI Requirements document on the national call website. The Spanish legal entities awarded grants are obliged by the regulations established in the PCI national call (or its equivalent) and by the funding limits specified below.			
Purpose of funding	The projects granted by the Agencia Estatal de Investigación must be aligned with the main objectives described in the Programa Estatal.			
Eligible Institutions	The eligible institutions are non-profit research organizations as per national call (PCI Requirements document), such as Universities, Public Research Institutions, Technological Centers, and other Private non-profit Institutions performing RDI activities in Spain.			
	The entities must have been previously beneficiaries of any of the AEI calls, as stated in the PCI Requirements document). They have to ensure contractual relationship with the Principal Investigator (PI) during all the implementation of the project.			
Eligible Applicants	 Principal Investigators (PIs) requesting funding to the AEI must: Be eligible to the corresponding PCI call (see PCI 2025-2 as an example) and PCI Requirements document. Demonstrate experience as investigators in projects funded by the different Plan Estatal I+D+i: 2013-2016, 2017-2020, 2021-2023, 2024-2027, ERC Grants, European Framework Programmes or other relevant national or international programmes. IMPORTANT and NEW! Submission of proposals at the AEI: Within one week after the pre-proposal submission, the Spanish PI must ALSO submit a proposal to the AEI. Pls will not be eligible for funding if they apply (i) to more than one proposal in this transnational joint call(ii) to more than one proposal in the same PCI call and/or (iii) to PCI calls of consecutive years. This means that the same PI may not apply in two or more international calls funded with PCI that are open simultaneously (e.g. Neuron Cofund Era Net, DUT, Biodiversa+ and Water4All), neither can they be awarded PCI grants in two consecutive years. If the same PI submits two or more proposals in this transnational call, they will all be declared ineligible without the possibility of changing the Pl. PI must remain unchanged between the proposal to this transnational call and the corresponding PCI call should the proposal be recommended for funding. A PI that has been granted a PCI the previous year will be declared ineligible, without the possibility of changing the Pl. Mere dissemination, communication or other similar activities will not be eligible unless supporting research activities. Only personnel costs for exclusive dedication to the project are eligible. The costs of permanent staff linked to the beneficiary entity or members of the research team will not be considered eligible costs. Direct costs such as current costs, scientific equipment, disposable materials, travelling expenses, coordination Eligible Costs costs and other costs that can be justified as necessary to carry out the proposed activities. The direct costs in the application must be rounded to the thousands Overheads (25% of all direct costs, including the subcontracting costs). The AEI will avoid double funding and will not grant projects or parts of projects already funded through other national or EU calls. **Maximum Amount Per Partner** Funding €200.000,00 direct costs per Partner per proposal Commitment Indirect costs must be added to direct costs: 25% of direct costs (including the subcontracting costs). (Only one Spanish partner is accepted per proposal) €250.000,00 total costs (including direct costs and indirect costs) Compliance with the funding limits will be considered under the eligibility criteria. Proposals not respecting these limits could be declared ineligible. Centres formed by different Spanish legal entities will be considered as a unique entity, and thus the maximum funding should not exceed the limits per proposal established above (for example, mixed centres).
