The Research State Agency of Spain (Agencia Estatal de Investigación, AEI) is the largest research funding body in Spain, promotes scientific and technical research through the efficient allocation of national and European public funds to universities, research centres, foundations and companies, ensuring transparent, rigorous and independent evaluation processes.

A DECADE OF SCIENCE FUNDING

Over the last decade, AEI has established itself as a key pillar of scientific and technological progress in Spain, supporting projects that strengthen our R&I system.

AEI was born out of a demand shared by the scientific community and enshrined in the 2011 Science, Technology and Innovation Act. This Act provided for the creation of a public entity to streamline and modernise the management of research funds and bring the Spanish model closer to international standards.

Since its creation, it has increased its budget to €1.286 billion in 2024 and has developed its structure, consolidating its focus on scientific excellence and organising itself into 19 areas of knowledge and 55 sub-areas.

It is a key player in Spain's economic and social progress. Its standards are comparable to those of European and international organisations. Although it is still young, it is establishing itself as a benchmark in its second decade.

IMPACT ON THE SCIENTIFIC COMMUNITY

The creation of the AEI has represented a decisive change in the way science is financed and organised in Spain. Its management has brought greater transparency, stability and competitiveness. Over the years, the AEI has consolidated a support model based on excellence and alignment with international standards , becoming a benchmark for researchers and institutions.



PROGRAMA

The AEI seeks to modernise the management of its grants by reducing administrative burdens and deadlines through unified calls for proposals, inter-institutional coordination, simplified payments, and digital communication tools, including AI. The aim is to increase efficiency and bring the organisation closer to the scientific community.

SOCIAL CHALLENGES

FIGHTING CANCER

Since 2018 , AEI has funded more than 1,300 cancer projects with €403.8 million. The AEI collaborates with organizations such as the Spanish Association Against Cancer (AECC) and the CRIS Cancer Foundation to ensure quality and transparency in research.

PUBLIC-PRIVATE = PARTNERSHIP

TECHNOLOGY PLATFORMS

This year marks the 20th anniversary of the Technology Platforms , public-private structures that promote collaboration in science and innovation. More than 60 platforms funded by the AEI work in energy, biotechnology and the circular economy to promote sustainability and decarbonisation.

SOCIAL IMPACT

CAMPAÑA ANTÁRTICA

Active since 1987, the Spanish Antarctic Campaign carries out scientific projects on climate change, biodiversity and geology at bases and on specialised vessels, notable for its international cooperation under the Antarctic Treaty. In its latest campaign, 300 people participated in 28 research projects.

FIGHT AGAINST MISINFORMATION IVERES PROJECT

The platform uses artificial intelligence to detect possible cases of disinformation in Spanish, thereby significantly reducing verification times. The platform coordinated by RTVE and several universities, it has received awards and is part of the state investment aimed at protecting the quality of information.

INVESTIGACIÓN DE FRONTERA

COMPHORT PROJECT: COMMUNICATION SECURE QUANTUM

The project COMPHORT, led by the Autonomous University of Madrid, is developing a quantum system to emit individual photons at room temperature. This breakthrough enables real-time encryption of communications, ideal for emergency situations without traditional infrastructure.

ASTRONOMY AND ASTROPHYSICS WITH A SPANISH STAMP

TRANSFER AND = INNOVATION

MATHEMATICS AGAINST CATASTROPHES

Researchers from the University of Malaga and the University of Seville designing series of capable algorithms of predicting maritime disasters such as tsunamis and floods in real time. These advanced models will improve contingency plans and preparedness for natural disasters.

INCLUSION AND DIVERSITY

DIGITAL PLATFORM FOR MENTAL HEALTH IN ADOLESCENTS

DIGITAS is a digital platform developed by the University of Jaén and funded by AEI and European Next Generation funds. It is aimed at preventing emotional problems in adolescents, such as Social Anxiety Disorder. To this end, it uses educational digital resources and content.

INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATION: A STRATEGIC PRIORITY

AEI promotes international collaboration, positioning the country among the EU leaders in Horizon Europe (2021-2027). It strengthens its participation in strategic sectors, global consortia and governance bodies to compete on equal terms, expand opportunities for collaboration and consolidate its role as a reliable partner in the construction of global knowledge.

International calls for proposals and projects

INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATION PROJECTS (PCI)

Key instrument adapted to align with international programmes. In 2024, 193 projects were funded with a budget of €46.2 million in 20 transnational programmes in strategic areas.

MANAGEMENT OF EUROPEAN PROJECTS AND INTERNATIONAL TALENT ATTRACTION (GPE)

It funds offices in universities and research centres to attract international talent and ensure a high scientific and economic return for Spain.

KEY PROGRAMMES

Throughout the year, AEI launches up to 21 open and competitive calls for proposals to fund public and private entities, which are grouped into three categories according to their main objective.



Research projects





Some of these calls for proposals are flagship because they are unique in the country and because their successful track record is a guarantee of their continuity.

PROYECTOS GENERACIÓN DE CONOCIMIENTO

More than €655 million in funding to support research groups in Spain. It was the largest call for proposals in Spain in 2024.

HUMAN RESOURCES FUNDING With programmes such as ATRAE, which offers €1 million to attract and retain talent, or the Ramón y Cajal grants, which have been incorporating highly qualified researchers into the Spanish science and technology system for 25 years.

PUBLIC-PRIVATE COLLABORATION PROJECTS

In 2024, €320 million was allocated to promoting strategic alliances between research centres, universities and companies that generate innovations with economic and social impact.

COMMITMENT TO EQUALITY, SUSTAINABILITY, AND OPEN SCIENCE

AEI maintains a firm commitment to **sustainability** in its operations and in the projects it funds. It seeks to promote environmentally friendly research that contributes to identifying solutions for achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).



AEI integrates gender **equality and diversity** as fundamental principles of its actions, as reflected in its Statutes. In 2018, it joined the H2020 SUPERA project, which led to the creation of the Strategic Gender Equality Group (GEI) and the approval of the First Gender Equality Plan 2021-2023. The Second Gender Equality Plan 2025-2027 is now in force, seeking to strengthen a more inclusive and diverse system.

The AEI promotes **Open Science** through its participation in the Spanish Open Science Strategy and National Open Science Strategy, and incorporates this philosophy into its calls for proposals. It collaborates in international forums, such as Science Europe's Research Culture group, to promote values of equality, integrity and scientific openness. Its endorsement to DORA (San Francisco Declaration on Research Assessment) reinforces fairer and more transparent evaluation.
